Little Priest Tribal College Liberal Arts, Associate of Science students may begin Briar Cliff University's Bachelor of Arts degree after completing 62 credits. Students from Little Priest Tribal College will need to complete 62 credits additional credits at BCU in order to meet the graduation requirement of 120 credits.
