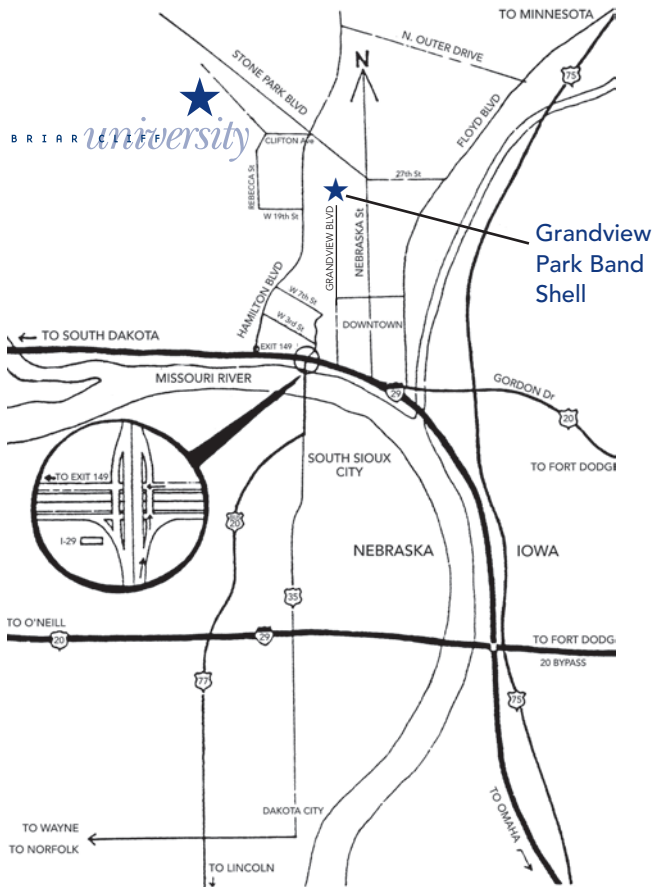

REGISTRATION OPTIONS: Participants may be COMMUTER or RESIDENTIAL students. The registration fee for COMMUTER students includes instruction, Sunday picnic, and social activities after the evening rehearsals. COMMUTER students may purchase meals if they wish. RESIDENTIAL students are assigned to double occupancy rooms in Alverno Hall, a supervised dormitory on the BCU campus. Participants **MUST BRING THEIR OWN LINENS** (towels, bedding and pillows). Meals are served in the dining hall, located in Stark Student Center. Camp attire is casual.
