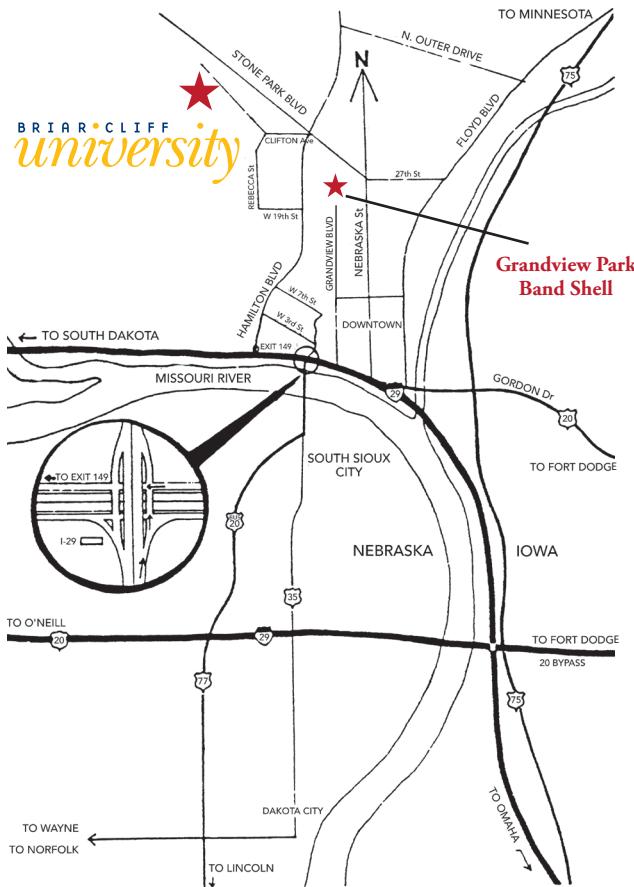

REGISTRATION OPTIONS: Participants may be COMMUTER or RESIDENTIAL students.
