PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The BSN degree program students may enter the program either through completing their AS degree in Indigenous Science with Health Concentration or completing the nursing pre-requisite courses and the general education requirements. Students completing the AS degree will have met all of the BCU general education requirements, with the exception of needing their Global Society course.

Students transferring into Briar Cliff University's Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program are to have completed nursing pre-requisite and general education courses with a 2.7 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).

Students only completing the pre-requisite courses and not earning the AS will be required to complete all Foundation courses for graduation with their BSN degree.
