### Grant Information

The College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007 created the Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program. This program provides up to \$4,000 per year (\$16,000 maximum for 4-year programs) in grants to undergraduate students who commit to 1) teach full-time 2) in high-need subject areas 3) for at least four years 4) at schools that serve students from low-income families. If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to a loan to be repaid by the recipient.
